Jarvis is the landlord, and given a good hot meal, and afterwards fitted out with fresh clothing, and the men were subsequently sent home.

The brigantine later in the day came ashore at Covehithe New. Her captain Reison, who is also the vessel's owner, stated that they had met with hazy weather off Cromer, with a strong S.E. head wind and heavy sea, and, when nearing Southwold, the *Economy*'s fore-topmast broke, leaving the vessel disabled. She was uninsured.

The Kessingland lifeboat also went to the vessel, but finding on one on the boat she ran for Lowestoft."
